MAC PAT met August 23, 1991 at Noon in the DMJHS Media Center.

President Stephanie Stank called the meeting to order.

Minutes from the informal officers meeting August 12 were read and approved by all present.

Reports:

Principle Report Dr. Brad Faught- welcomed everyone to the school year and stated everything was well – we have great kids DMJHS is in a pilot with Solution Tree – we are one of 9 schools working on building instructions into cycles of 5 -10 days to recognize issues early. Teachers spend 180 min a week to plan instructions.

DMJHS has 722 kids enrolled – at full capacity. The school may need to add classroom space in the future.

The first dance in the new gym was well attended and supervised.

Dr. Faught made a request for PAT to consider funding or partial funding to cap the bleachers with pads and new paint. The first estimates were \$30,000. More information will be forthcoming.
